## What We Stand For



We One Action Network (WOAN) is committed to partnering with registered NGOs and Community Based Organizations. Our primary focus is educational learning (i.e., life skills, classroom) and other essentials including mentorship programs, youth development, food & nutrition, school supplies & uniforms, and sanitary pads to keep young girls in school.

WOAN-supported initiatives are designed to encourage the highest standards of creativity and long-term self-reliance. Since our inception in 2018, we have positioned ourselves as part of the solution by listening and engaging with leaders that understand what those gaps are. In return, WOAN can remain on the frontline in our quest to assist vulnerable and disadvantaged students and educators.





# KIBERA GIRLS SOCCER ACADEMY | ALUMNAE ASSOCIATION

KGSA provides a free, holistic high school education to 130 girls annually. The school emphasizes leadership and character development through extracurricular activities and employs university-trained teachers, setting it apart from other schools in Kibera. KGSA cares for the whole girl by providing sanitary pads, school tea and lunch, preventative and acute health care, and a social worker to support their mental health. The new dormitory provides three meals a day and a safe, stable learning environment. In 2022, WOAN sponsored their Alumnae Association that provide sewing training for some of their students. Shine Academy Educational Center (SAEC) is **WOANs sponsored school**. We are a private pre-primary and lower primary school. We are in the urban low income, informal settlement (i.e., slum) of Kibera within Nairobi, the Kenyan national capital. We operate in a small property of two rented buildings in the main Olympic estate in Kibera.

SAECs vision is to offer quality education to orphan and disadvantaged children. Their mission is to provide vulnerable children with an opportunity to pursue their dreams through education that encompasses classroom learning, mentorship and life-skills.

Tribeless Youth is a youth initiative established in 2016 with a view to promote peaceful coexistence among the youth in Kenya. The organization uses art, music and creativity to demystify the ideologies of “my tribe, my people” with a view to galvanize unity among Kenya’s youthful generation.

They advocate for a mental shift from tribal-based stereotypes to issue-based politics where leaders are elected out of their competence and policies and not because of their tribe.
