Food Forest

We are establishing a food forest at the Umala Vocational Training Centre to promote food security and access to good nutrition for students, especially young and adolescent mothers and their children.

It is understood that there is no learning without food. The food forest will equally generate income by selling its products to community and local markets. This return investment will create income to support their feeding program while promoting self-sustainability.



Children-Friendly Play Space

We are building a children-friendly play space at Umala Vocational Training Centre to support young and adolescent mothers with children who have difficulty finding a place to leave their children to attend training sessions.

The safe space will give mothers a break and peace of mind so they can focus on their training. This play space will be decorated with children's friendly and educational items, which will allow the children to play and promote early learning and development.
